- Children are required to wear school uniform with long hair tied back
- Children will take a water bottle
- Children will have lunch when they return to school (except for nursery children who are not in in the afternoon)
- **Nursery children** – booster seats are required to be brought in on the day

On the day of the show the timetable is :-

- 9:00am children leave Tackley School by coach
- 9:50am children arrive at the theatre for the 10:00am performance
- approx. 11:15pm children leave the theatre
- approx. 12:00 noon children return to school and nursery children are picked up (if not in in the afternoon)

- Please note the slightly later lunchtime pick up time on this day (timing will be traffic dependent) and that the nursery will be closed on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> December for nursery children not on the trip.
