**Anning Trip to The Cotswold Wildlife Park : Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2026**

Dear Parents/Carers

Please see below some details for an Anning Class trip next term which all nursery children are invited to join us :-

- The parent/carer contribution request is **£19.25** – **please complete your consent and contribution by Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March via ParentPay [here](#).**
- Children are required to wear school uniform with long hair tied back
- Children need to bring a packed lunch with them on the day.
  - school packed lunches are free for Reception children (UIFSM scheme) and £3.15 for Nursery children
  - If you would like to order a school packed lunch, please email the school office to confirm and to confirm your child's roll choice (cheese or ham) **by Friday 13<sup>th</sup> February**
- Children will take a water bottle.

On the day of the trip the timetable is :-

- 9:15am children leave Tackley School by coach
- 10:00am children arrive at the wildlife park
- approx. 2:00pm children leave the wildlife park
- approx. 2:45pm children return to school

The nursery will be closed on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> March for nursery children not on the trip.

**Nursery children:** Under UK law, children aged **3 and over** can travel without a child car seat or seat belt, if they're not available. The coach company that we have booked has seat belts fitted and they recommend travelling using the belt and without a child car seat, however if you wish you are able to provide a child car seat.

If you intend to provide a child seat, we kindly ask that you:

- Provide an appropriate child seat for your child.
- Label the seat clearly with your child's name.
- Ensure the seat meets current safety standards.

This trip can only run if we receive sufficient voluntary contributions from parents. School budgets are increasingly stretched and we are no longer in a position where we can run school trips at a loss. We appreciate your support with this.
